STEP 1

### Spray Bottle Cleaning:



**1**

Cover, unplug and turn off all electrical equipment to be cleaned. Remove any large soils from work tables and counters by wiping them into a trash can with a clean dry cloth.

**2**

Fill Cleaning bottle and Sanitizing\* bottle using 3-compartment sink procedures

**3**

Spray **Spirit II** solution onto a food service paper towel. Wipe surface thoroughly to remove any remaining soils.

**4**

Rinse with clean water using water-labelled spray bottle. Wipe dry with food service paper towels.

**5**

To sanitize, use Sanitizing\* bottle to spray all surfaces previously cleaned by Spirit II until completely wet. Let air dry.
